General Comments:

Hand wash station had soap and paper towels. The cold holding unit was measured at satisfactory temperatures per the state law. Nozzles in the soda machine were free of mildew.

In the last inspection report, it was noted that the bathroom must be fixed and the wall that incurred a vehicle collision must be sealed properly to restrict air flow into the store. It was verified today that the bathroom has been fixed. A new toilet seat has been installed. The wall has been properly sealed. The operator notified that a new wall shall be installed by April 1, 2016.
